Update for the Reverse Osmosis Plant for the City of Wheeler's water supply:

Water samples were sent to Environmental Monitoring Laboratory, LLC Feb. 14 for analysis. Results show that the drinking water being supplied to customers has dropped below Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for nitrate. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has established the MCL for nitrate to be 10 milligrams per liter (mg/L) based on a single sample. The City Water Department will be monitoring water samples on an ongoing basis to ensure safe levels for the public's consumption.
