

ORDINANCE # 174

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING WATER RATE CHARGES IN CITY LIMITS OF WHEELER, TEXAS AND MAKING PROVISIONS FOR RATES OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS.

All Ordinances and resolutions pertaining to the setting of charges to be made to citizens of Wheeler, Texas for their use of water are hereby repealed. The rates to be charged for the March 1997 billing date forward until further repealed or ordinance shall be as follows:

WATER RATES	RESIDENCE	COMMERCIAL
First 3,000 gallons or part thereof	\$7.50	\$9.50
Next 8,000 gallons	\$1.25 per thousand	\$1.25 per thous
All over 11,000 gal	\$.95 per thousand	\$.95 per thous

All water customers outside City Limits will be charged \$14.00 minimum for the first 3,000 gallons or parts thereof. Charges for additional gallons will be same as in City limits.

NU-METRICS Traffic Analyzer Study
Computer Generated Summary Report

Route: SH 152

Location: X-SH 152 & CAN. ST.

STUDY

A survey of vehicle traffic was conducted with HISTAR unit number 3209. The survey was done in the WBL lane on SH 152 in WHEELER, TX in WHEELER county. The survey lasted for 24 hours and began on Tuesday, March 4, 1997 at 2:30pm and ended on Wednesday, March 5, 1997 at 2:30pm. Data were recorded in 60 minute time periods. The total recorded volume of traffic showed 1553 vehicles passed through the location with a peak volume of 162 on Wednesday, March 5, 1997 at 12:30pm and a minimum volume of 2 on Wednesday, March 5, 1997 at 3:30am.

SPEED

Chart 1 lists the values of the speed bins and the total volume for each bin.

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Half of the vehicles were traveling at 28.1 mph or lower speed. The average speed for all classified vehicles was 29.93 mph with 14.18 percent exceeding the posted speed of 35 mph. The HI-STAR found 0.07 percent of the vehicles were traveling in excess of 55 mph. The mode speed for this traffic study was 30 mph and the 85th percentile was 35.3 mph.

CLASS

Chart 2 lists the values of the 8 class bins and the total volume for each bin.

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Most of the vehicles were passenger cars with a total count of 1243. This represents 96.27 percent of the classified vehicles. The truck percentage is 3.73 percent of the classified vehicles.
