

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A ELECTRICAL  
CODE FOR THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS,  
TO DEFINE FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES  
OF SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS  
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. CREATION. An Electrical Code for the City of  
Wheeler, Texas is now created. Its purpose and powers are to  
promote the science and improve the methods of fire protection.  
The National Electrical Code, 1968, Edition is adopted in whole,  
and the same is in effect as if all written in this ordinance.  
3 copies of this Code are on file in the office of the City  
Secretary, City of Wheeler, Texas.

#### SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

Wherever the word "Municipality" is used in the Electrical Code, it shall be held to mean the City of Wheeler.

#### SECTION 3. VALIDITY.

The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance or of the electrical code hereby adopted shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

#### SECTION 4. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.

Ordinances or parts thereof in force at the time that this ordinance shall take effect and inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

#### SECTION 5. DATE OF EFFECT

This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval.
