

ORDINANCE NO. 184

TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 19

REGULATING THE KEEPING OF CHICKENS AND OTHER FOWLS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION No.1 Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person firm or corporation to permit any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys, or any fowl of any kind to run at large, during any month of the year within in the incorporated limits of said city. Any person, firm or corporation permitting any fowl to leave his own premises or the premises he controls and allows same to stray upon the premises of another, same shall be deemed to be "run-at-large" as that term is herein above used.

SECTION No. 2 Any person firm, or corporation violating the provisions of the ORDINANCE shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding fifty dollars.

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.
