

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING ANY OBSTRUCTION
OF A SIDE WALK WITHIN CERTAIN LIMITS
OF THE CITY TO CONSTITUTE A NUISANCE;
PROHIBITING SAME AND PRESCRIBING A
PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

That any box, crate, barrel, merchandise or any other obstruction upon any sidewalk adjacent to the premises described below is, and shall be hereafter, classed as a nuisance, and it hereby prohibited. No person, firm or corporation shall hereafter permit any box, crate, merchandise or any other obstruction to remain upon any such sidewalk adjacent to lots Nos. 7 to 18 inclusive in Block No. 15; All of Block No. 16; Lots Nos. 1 to 18 in Block No. 17; All of Block No. 20; All of Block No. 22; Lots Nos. 1 to 12 in Block No. 27; Lots Nos. 1 to 12 and 18 to 24 in Block No. 28; and Lots Nos. 1 to 18 in Block No. 29.

Provided, however, that this ordinance shall not be construed as prohibiting the moving of any box, barrel, crate, merchandise, etc., across any such sidewalk so long as such be not permitted to remain on such sidewalk for a longer period of time than one hour, and provided further that such shall not prohibit the obstruction of any such sidewalk immediately in front of any building under construction or repair, when such obstruction is reasonably necessary to the erection or repair of such building.

Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$25.00. Each day this ordinance shall be violated shall be, and constitute, a separate offense.
