

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT CITY ALDERMEN SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE PLACE SYSTEM  
Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Wheeler, Wheeler  
County, Texas:

That for the betterment of the government of the City of Wheeler, Texas,  
and in accordance with Article 980b. of the Texas Civil Statutes, as amended,  
it is hereby ordained from the date of this ordinance forward that all City  
Aldermen shall be elected by the place system and a place number shall be  
assigned to each of the five present aldermen so that in all City Elections,  
after 60 days following the passing of this ordinance, the City Aldermen  
will be elected at large according to place numbers assigned to each Alderman  
by the City Council.

The fact that the necessity of the passing of this ordinance creates an  
emergency, the rule requiring three readings of this ordinance is hereby suspended
