ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE ADAPTING THE PENAL CODE AND CODE OF PROCEDURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS

BE IT ORDAINED By the City Council of the Town of Wheeler, Texas as follows:

Whereas the said City of Wheeler, Texas is now incorporated with a Mayor's Court, and whereas said Court has concurrent jurisdiction with Justice Courts of Texas, be it resolved that the laws of Texas as shown by the penal code and code of procedure governing and defining misdemeanors, to which misdemeanor no jail penalty is attached and of which misdemeanors Justice Courts have jurisdiction, be adopted by the City of Wheeler as laws governing misdemeanors within the limits of the City.

All persons guilty of violating such laws shall be fined, upon conviction, as prescribed by the penal code of the State of Texas. Witness our official signatures this the 8th day of July, 1925.
