

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING
A LICENSE TAX UPON AUCTIONEERS WITH-
IN THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS, AND
FIXING A PENALTY FOR OPERATING AS
AN AUCTIONEER WITHOUT HAVING FIRST
PAID SUCH TAX.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

That there be, and thereis hereby, levied and assessed a license tax of \$5.00 per annum upon every auctioneer who shall hereafter do, or offer to do business, within the City of Wheeler, Texas, by holding or crying, or offering to hold or cry, an auction sale within said city. Such tax shall be paid before any person shall hold, or offer to hold, any auction sale within said city.

Any person who shall hold or cry, or offer to hold or cry, any auction sale, or to sell any object, whether tangible or intangible, by auction sale within the City of Wheeler, Texas, without having first paid the license tax above mentioned shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$25.00. Each day any person shall violate this ordinance shall be and constitute a seperate offence.

This ordinance shall not be construed as giving authority for any auction sale upon a street or alley of said city.

This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.
