

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE UPON ANY STREET OR ALLEY OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS, AT PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AUCTION, BY HAWKING OR PEDDLING, BY OFFERING FOR SALE FROM ANY VEHICLE OR STAND OR IN ANY OTHER MANNER, ANY GOODS, WARES OR MERCHANDISE OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, OR ANY FRUIT, ANY LIVE-STOCK OR MACHINERY, ANY HOUSEHOLD GOODS OR FARM PRODUCTS OR ANY MEAT OR ANY MEDICINE AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

That from and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer for sale upon any street or alley of the City of Wheeler, Texas, at public or private auction sale, by hawking or peddling, by offering for sale from any vehicle or stand or in any other manner, any goods, wares or merchandise of what-so-ever nature, any fruit any livestock or machinery, any household goods or farm products, any meat or any medicines.

Any person violating any provision of this act shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00..

Provided that each day any provision hereof shall be violated by any person shall be and constitute a seperate offence; and provided further that this ordinance shall not apply to any person who is a bonafide resident of Wheeler County, Texas, or the South-half of Hemphill County, Texas, who shall sell or offer for sale any above named product which was produced exclusively upon his own premises or by his own skill and labor.
