

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR GENERAL PURPOSES TO PAY THE CURRENT EXPENSES FOR, AND WITHIN, THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS LEVIED FOR THE CURRENT YEAR OF A. D. 1925; PROVIDING FOR THE TIME WHEN SUCH TAX OR TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND PAYABLE; AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR NON-PAYMENT THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

Sec. 1. That there be, and there is hereby, levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the city of Wheeler Texas, for the current year of A.D. 1925, for the general purpose of meeting and paying current expenses of said city, the sum of twenty-five cents (.25¢) upon the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation upon all such taxable property.

Sec. 2. All taxes hereby levied, and which may be hereafter levied, by the City of Wheeler, Texas, shall be due on or before the 1st day of January of the year immediately following the year for which levied, and if not paid by the 31st day of such month of January there shall be added as a penalty the sum of 10% upon such tax, or taxes, as well as all cost of collection.

Sec. 3. Provided, however, that all license fees and occupation taxes shall be due and payable on or before the first day of January of the year for which such tax is levied or assessed.

Sec. 4. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for the immediate welfare of said city, it shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
