ORDINANCE 153

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADMISSION RATES AND ADMISSION PROCEDURES AT THE CITY OF WHEELER SWIMMING POOL:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wheeler has determined that the ordinance set forth below would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Wheeler, now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

Section 1.

- (1) The City of Wheeler Swimming Pool will open on Saturday, May 26, 1990, at 1:00 o'clock p.m. All persons seeking admittance must complete an emergency admission card prior to admittance.
- (2) Admission charges for the 1990 season shall be as follows:
 - (a) Children twelve (12) and under \$1.00;
 - (b) Adults thirteen (13) and over \$1.50;
 - (c) ladies swim \$2.00.

HOURS:

12:00-1:00 p.m. Tuesday thru Friday (ladies only)
1:00-6:00 p.m. Tuesday thru Saturday (open to public)

1:00-5:00 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday (family swim) Children admitted only with a parent who is swimming.

CLOSED: Mondays (except Memorial Day)

Section 2.

(3) There shall be no season passes offered for the 1990 season. Admission will be by punch card, and punches may be purchased in advance and used during the season.

PRICES FOR PUNCH CARDS:

Children 12 and under

10 punches - 9.00

20 punches -17.00

25 punches -21.00

Adults

10 punches -14.00

20 punches -28.00

25 punches -35.00

- (4) All punch cards will be kept in the City of Wheeler Swimming Pool office and punched and dated as used.
- (5) The pool will be available for pricate parties for two hours from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00p.m.. Reservations must be made at the pool office. A deposit of \$15.00 will be needed to reserve the pool and the remaining \$15.00 the night of the party. Price is \$30.00 for the first 20 swimmers plus \$1.00 for each person over 20.
- (6) The City Secretary is hereby authorized to cause publication of the descriptive caption of this ordinance as an alternative method provided by law.
