

ORDINANCE 178**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE
ELECTED TO OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF WHEELER.**

WHEREAS: Chapter C has been added to E.C. Chapter 2, providing for cancellation of certain elections. In a general election for the governing body of a political subdivision other than a county the election may be canceled if no candidate is opposed and no proposition is to appear on the ballot.

WHEREAS: The city secretary has certified to City Council that only one name is to be placed on the ballot for each office and no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidate for any of the offices on the ballot for the City of Wheeler.

WHEREAS: The city secretary certifies that Walter Simmons, candidate for Council member Place # 1 and Barbra Koelzer, candidate for Council member Place # 3, and Mark Frankenbery, candidate for Council member Place # 5 are all unopposed for that office.

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance with Subchapter C of E.C. Chapter 2, I Claudine Finsterwald, certify the above candidates be elected to the offices listed above on order of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheeler, Texas.
