

ORDINANCE NO. 58-A

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS,
CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLAR-
ING THE RESULTS OF A ONE PERCENT
(1%) SALES AND USE TAX ELECTION
HELD IN THE CITY OF WHEELER,
TEXAS, ON DECEMBER 4, 1968.

WHEREAS, there came on to be considered returns of a one per cent (1%) sales and use tax election heretofore held on DECEMBER 4, 1968, in the City of Wheeler, Texas, at which election there was submitted to the resident qualified electors of the City of Wheeler, Texas, for their action thereupon, the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION

"Shall the electors of the City of Wheeler, Texas adopt a one per cent (1%) local sales and use tax within the City of Wheeler Texas?"

and

WHEREAS, this City Council has diligently inquired into the poll list and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to this City Council by the judge and clerks holding and conducting said election, and this City Council hereby affirmatively finds that all voters who cast ballots at said election were resident qualified electors of the City of Wheeler, Texas, and that there were cast at said election 372 votes, of which number there were cast FOR and AGAINST the proposition submitted as follows, to-wit:

FOR	The adoption of a one per cent (1%) local sales and use tax within the City.	<u>224</u> votes
AGAINST	The adoption of a one per cent (1%) local sales and use tax within the City.	<u>148</u> votes

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT FOUND, DECLARED AND BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS.

I

That a majority of the resident qualified electors of the City of Wheeler, Texas, voting at said election, voted in favor of the adoption of a one per cent (1%) local sales and use tax within the City.

PASSED, ADOPTED AND APPROVED on this, the 19th day of December 1968.
