

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AND REGULATING THE KEEPING OF HOGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WHEELER, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the Town of Wheeler, Texas as follows:

SECTION 1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep hogs on any of the premises located in the city limits of the City of Wheeler, Texas, upon any of the described metes and bounds: All of Blocks 15, 16, 17, 20, 22, 27, 28, 29.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep a greater number than two head of hogs in the remaining part of the corporate limits of the City of Wheeler, Texas, not set out in Section 1 hereof, and it shall be unlawful for any person to keep even as many as two hogs in the territory defined in this section within 250 feet of the private residence of any person.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than One Dollar nor more than One Hundred Dollars.
