

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RATES FOR
ELECTRICITY AND AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. __, DATED AUGUST 12, 1927

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELER, WHEELER COUNTY, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

Ordinance No. __, dated August 12, 1927, of the City of Wheeler, Texas, is amended as follows:

"SECTION 8. On and after the date hereof, the rates for electric energy furnished to consumers in the corporate limits of the City of Wheeler, Texas, shall not be in excess of the following:

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

APPLICABLE: To residential customers for lighting and incidental purposes, including the operation of electric refrigerators or ranges where used in private residences, individual family apartments and in private garages. Motors not to exceed 5 hp, individual capacity, may be served under this rate.

RATE	First	50 kwh used per month @ 6.60¢ per kwh
	Next	50 kwh used per month @ 3.85¢ per kwh
	Additional	kwh used per month @ 2.20¢ per kwh
CHARACTER OF SERVICE:	A-c; 60 cycles; single phase 120/240 volts, or where available, three phase 240 volts.	
MONTHLY MINIMUM:	\$1.50 per month.	

GENERAL SERVICE

APPLICABLE: To all commercial and industrial electric service supplied at one point of delivery, and measured through one kilowatt-hour meter, where facilities of adequate capacity and suitable voltage are adjacent to the premises to be served.

Not applicable to temporary, breakdown, standby, supplementary resale or shared service. Not applicable to customers having seasonal load characteristics. Not applicable to customers having major electric energy contracts.

RATE	6.60¢ per kwh for the first	100 kwh used per mo.*
	3.85¢ per kwh for the next	900 kwh used per mo.
	2.00¢ per kwh for the next	6,000 kwh used per mo.
	1.00¢ per kwh for the next	12,000 kwh used per mo.
	.75¢ per kwh for all additional	kwh used per mo.

* Add to the 3.85¢ block 42 kwh for each kw of demand in excess of 10kw.

DEMAND: The Company will furnish at its expense the necessary metering equipment to measure the customer's kw demand for the .30-minute period of greatest use during the month.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT: The net charge per kilowatt hour of the above rate shall be increased or decreased 0.01¢ (one hundredth of one cent) per kwh for each 0.5¢ (five tenths of one cent) increase or decrease, or major fraction thereof, in the delivered cost of gas at all of the Company's steam-electric generating stations above 12.5¢ or below 10.5¢ per thousand cubic feet during the second preceding month.

TYPE OF SERVICE: A-c; 60 cycles; single or three phase, at one available standard voltage.

MONTHLY MINIMUM: \$1.50 per month for demands of 10kw or less, plus \$1.50 per kw for all additional kw. No demand shall be taken as less than 50% of highest demand established in 12 months ending with current month. In no event shall minimum charge be less than \$1.50 per meter for single phase service or \$5.00 per meter for three phase service.

"The schedule of rates and charges set forth in this ordinance shall not interfere with or limit the right of the Southwestern Public Service Company, its successors and assigns, to establish, from time to time, a schedule of rates and charges applicable to any class of service not covered by the schedules herein set forth nor to establish, from time to time, reasonable minimum or demand charges where such charges are not provided for in this ordinance. The privilege and right are granted to the Southwestern Public Service Company, its successors and assigns, to make special contracts from time to time, commonly known to the Electrical Industry as major electric energy contracts, which may become necessary in the conduct of the business of the Southwestern Public Service Company, its successors and assigns, to encourage the use of electrical energy in the territory served by the Southwestern Public Service Company, its successors and assigns."

Introduced on the 5 day of August, 1957 and passed by the City Council as the governing body of the City of Wheeler, Texas, on this the 5 day of August, 1957.
